

CONCESSIONS/GATE/CLEAN-UP SCHEDULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Based upon the number of baseball players and the number of slots that we have to fill (175), **we need each player's parent(s) to sign up for a total of 4 slots (clean-up, gate and/or concession stand) throughout the season.**

Sign up is taking place now using the web-based program, "My Sign-Up".

Attempts to include all sign-ups on one website made for a very large layout which would be too confusing and cumbersome for the users. [This was because of the level of complexity in our baseball program schedule: Saturday, week night and tournament games with varied game start times; double headers and 3 types of responsibilities (concessions, gate, clean-up) with their own time blocks for working.]

Because of this, we have 3 web addresses for sign-ups (it really is easier with 3 than with one huge sign-up site!):

1. Saturday games
 - 4 Saturdays
 - one of which [February 27th] is the only day that the Freshmen play at Spain Park with Varsity and/or JV teams.

2. Weekday games

3. Freshmen Spring Break tournament
 - 3 days: March 15-17
 - Since the Varsity is at Hoover and the JV at Trussville for their Spring Break tournaments, the Freshmen team is responsible for all hosting activities for this tournament.

When you make your choice of commitments to activity time slots, it is your responsibility to make certain that you or someone else is there to fulfill that commitment.* **WE HAVE NO POOL OF FILL-IN PEOPLE TO COVER MISSED ASSIGNMENTS.** [The GATE is particularly important since only one person is there and tickets need to be sold beginning 1 hour before the first game. We lose much money by not having the gate "manned".]

[*Your commitments on the My Sign-Up site can easily be removed/changed by you (for example, if you swap a commitment with someone else) as long as you remember the password that you have selected when signing up (pick an easy one!). Once your slot is re-opened, the person you swapped with should go to the website and sign themselves up to fill the slot(s). If you get in a bind, please don't be a no-show – at least contact your team rep (Freshmen: Suzanne Mullens; JV: *volunteer needed*; Varsity: Kathy Snyder).]

Suggestions:

- Varsity and JV parents: come and work the Freshmen games (noted with an “F” on the scheduled day’s headers).
- Freshmen parents: after the first week of the season, the Freshmen don’t play the same days as JV and Varsity so please come work on those days!
- Sign up for your preferred slots as soon as possible, since they are “first come, first choices”.
